Recipe – Simple idea for Goat's Cheese

Pancetta or streaky bacon (see Trunkey Ham and bacon)

Goat's Cheese (see Leaning Oak Dairy)

Baguettes (see Bakehouse or Shepherd's Bakehouse)

Marinated capsicum or eggplant (see Olive Sensation)

Crisp pancetta in the oven, whilst melting goat's cheese on sliced, toasted baguettes (croutons). Serve the croutons with pancetta and marinated capsicum or eggplant.

To make the croutons gluten-free, see Shepherd's Bakehouse for gluten-free bread)
